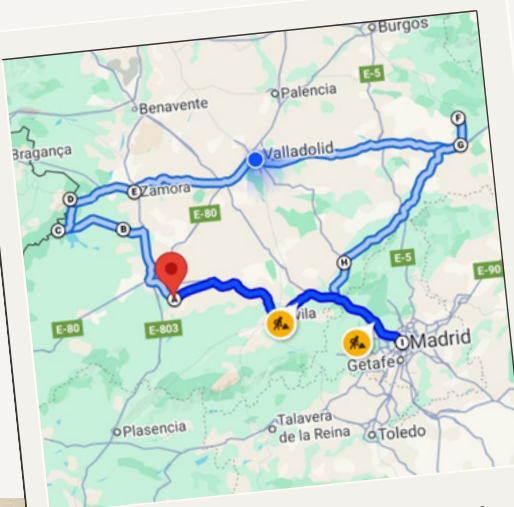

Itinerario

Day 1: The Mystical Castilian Lands

Depart from Madrid via Ávila and Alba de Tormes, arriving in Zamora. Accommodation and dinner included.

(For groups arriving by plane, stops may be reduced or skipped. For arrivals after 6:00 PM, the group will stay overnight in Ávila and continue to Zamora the following day, adding one night and day to the base program.)

Day 2: The Three Magpies – Memories of Three Great Women

Begin the day admiring the serene beauty of the Almendra Reservoir, also known as the "Sea of Castile," en route to Famoselle, famed as the "Village of a Thousand Wineries," where we will explore the fascinating underground city. (Optional Gourmet Experience – CGO)

After lunch, return to the hotel with stops at two of the region's most beautiful spiritual sites: the Hermitages of Fariza and the Virgin of Grace. Dinner included.

Day 3: The Fjords of the Douro River and Other Hidden Treasures

Depart for the Douro River Natural Park for a boat tour, concluding with a tasting of the renowned Porto wines. Visit Miranda do Douro and its famous "Menino das Estrelas." (CGO)
In the afternoon, explore the stunning landscapes around the iconic "Pino Bridge," a remarkable feat of Spanish civil engineering. Return to the hotel and dinner included.

Day 4: Mysteries, Wishes, and Dreams of Sayago – Return to Zamora

Immerse yourself in the historical mysteries and legends of Sayago, meeting some of the area's most inspiring dreamers and entrepreneurs. Enjoy a narrated and musical walk culminating in a farewell lunch before returning to Zamora. After dinner, enjoy a magical nighttime stroll in the city, guaranteed to leave you "enZamorados" (enchanted).



📍 Valladolid

Day 5: Laws and Treaties of the New World

Discover the fascinating history of Toro, including a visit to its Collegiate Church and a cheese tasting. (CGO)

After lunch, explore Tordesillas, reflecting on its historical importance and strategic position, before continuing to Valladolid for a panoramic tour of the vibrant capital. Accommodation and dinner included, with the option of a guided nighttime walk or free exploration.

Day 6: Treasures of Soria

Depart for Peñafiel to admire its impressive castle. Continue to the Hermitage of Bartolomé in the Lobos River Canyon.

(Optional Gastronomic Treat at the Natural Park Restaurant)

Proceed to the medieval city of Burgo de Osma for a walking tour, then continue to San Esteban de Gormaz or Aranda de Duero. Accommodation and dinner included.

Day 7: Roman Memories in the Lands of the Comuneros

Depart for Madrid via Riaza and Segovia, visiting both locations as flight schedules allow. For Madrid-based passengers, both towns will be visited, with a farewell lunch included before returning to Madrid.
